### Customer

The Laramie County School District 2 in Wyoming serves six schools – four elementary, and two junior/senior high schools.

### Challenge And Solution

#### Providing multiple options and flexibility to educators to facilitate 21<sup>st</sup> century instruction

- COW (Computers On Wheels) – mobile netbook carts to encourage widespread use among multiple grades
- Provide computer lab alternatives to educators – music lessons were imparted using netbooks to first and second grade students using software to help them identify different instruments in a game format individually as the labs were occupied by statewide testing (Proficiency Assessments for Wyoming Students – PAWS) students.
